

Palestine Emergency Appeal launched by Action For Humanity

Action For Humanity, a UK-based humanitarian aid NGO, have announced they are launching a full scale emergency appeal to aid people impacted by the escalating violence Palestinians are currently impacted by.

Action For Humanity has been working in Palestine since 2021 and, as well as providing humanitarian aid in the last two waves of violence, they are supporting Palestinians in the West Bank and Gaza with access to food, clean water, medical and supporting orphans. Action For Humanity's team in Palestine are currently assessing the spiralling humanitarian needs and will deliver aid according to what those impacted need most to save and sustain lives.

Othman Moqbel, Chief Executive Officer of Action For Humanity, says:

“Once again Palestinians are facing worsening humanitarian conditions, caused by an increase in violence. This has once again fallen during a time when many Palestinians are celebrating the holy month of Ramadan.

“We have a pedigree of providing humanitarian aid to Palestinians during escalations of violence, like this, as well as over 12 years of providing humanitarian aid in conflict zones like Syria and Yemen. We have been monitoring the tensions in the West Bank and Gaza for months and, sadly, the conditions caused by the escalation of violence have triggered the protocol for Action For Humanity to launch an emergency fundraising appeal.

“We have been working in Palestine for years, providing emergency aid, as well as food, water, medical and support for orphans. We are calling on the public to donate generously to help us save and sustain lives in Palestine.”
