February Fundraising Tour:


Our 12-event tour was a huge success, with many events selling out and exceeding expectations.

BUILDING MOMENTUM IN 2025

NEWLY LAUNCHED PROJECTS

SUPPORTING VULNERABLE CHILDREN IN YEMEN

The Challenge: Yemen's healthcare system is on the brink of collapse, leaving children without access to life-saving care.

Our Response: Action for Humanity is proud to launch a critical initiative to strengthen specialized healthcare services for vulnerable children in Al Sadaqa Hospital, Aden, Yemen;

- 89 frontline health workers with monthly incentives
- 23,500 vulnerable children and individuals relying on the hospital

Impact: By retaining skilled staff and covering partial running costs, we ensure continuity of emergency care and strengthen the hospital's response to child health crises.

EMPOWERING EDUCATION IN YEMEN

The Challenge: Vulnerable children in Lahj face significant educational gaps due to damaged infrastructure, lack of resources, and heightened risks of early marriage and school dropout.

Our Response: Action for Humanity is dedicated to creating safe and inclusive learning environments for conflict-affected children in Lahj Governorate, Yemen;

- Constructing 4 new classrooms and rehabilitating damaged school infrastructure
- Providing school furniture, learning materials, and gender-sensitive sanitation facilities
- Connecting the school to a solar-powered water well for clean and reliable water supply

Impact: By improving infrastructure, promoting hygiene, and engaging local communities, we're creating a safer, more dignified environment for 300 vulnerable children to learn and thrive.



HARBOR

Helping Agriculture Rebuild for Better Outcomes & Resilience
-Farming & Fishery program in
Yemen

•THE CHALLENGE:

Yemen's ongoing conflict has devastated the fishery and agriculture sectors, leaving millions without a steady income and exacerbating food insecurity.

•OUR RESPONSE:

Action for Humanity is proud to launch two groundbreaking projects, HARBOR I and HARBOR II, aimed at restoring the livelihoods of vulnerable fishing and farming communities in Yemen.

•HARBOR I:

Fishery Project: Providing 150 medium-sized boats and training to 300 fishermen and fisherwomen in Hudaydah and Aden governorates.

•HARBOR II:

Farming Project: Distributing 75 farming tractors to support 300 households and conducting 45 training sessions for 450 farmers on sustainable farming practices.

•IMPACT:

By equipping fisherfolk and farmers with essential tools and knowledge, we're helping to rebuild the fishery and agriculture sectors, reduce food insecurity, and improve the resilience of affected households.

•PARTNERSHIP:

We're grateful for the funding support from **ICNA RELIEF CANADA**, making these critical projects possible.



URGENT MEDICAL AID FOR GAZA

THE CRISIS:

Years of blockade, conflict, and destruction have overwhelmed Gaza's health system, with severe shortages in essential medicines and supplies.

OUR RESPONSE:

Action for Humanity is responding to the deepening healthcare crisis in Gaza with a life-saving initiative, delivering urgent medical assistance to two key hospitals: Nasir and Al Aqsa. We're supplying essential medical items to benefit 10,000 patients, including:

- Life-saving medicines
- Critical medical equipment

IMPACT:

By restoring the supply of vital medical items, we're addressing immediate healthcare needs and supporting the continuity of essential medical services in Gaza.

FOOD RELIEF FOR GAZA

THE CRISIS:

Growing food insecurity and the ongoing humanitarian crisis in Gaza have left many families without stable sources of income, struggling to meet their basic needs.

OUR RESPONSE:

Action for Humanity is contributing with the delivery of 20,000 food parcels to vulnerable communities in Gaza, providing essential staples to 27,500 individuals in need. We're delivering food parcels containing: Flour, Rice, Cooking oil, Pasta & Other essential items.

IMPACT:

This project delivers life-saving food relief, reinforces community resilience, and helps families recover, survive, and maintain their dignity amid crises.



BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY FOR ORPHANED CHILDREN

Action for Humanity is on a mission to empower vulnerable orphaned children in Palestine, Syria, and Yemen to dream big and build a brighter future!

REAL IMPACT, REAL CHANGE

- Palestine: 126 orphaned children supported, 630 lives touched
- Syria: 4 orphaned children sponsored, 20 lives transformed
- Yemen: 27 orphaned children sponsored, 135 lives empowered

OUR APPROACH

- Careful beneficiary selection based on age, school enrolment, and household income
- Home visits to verify living conditions and track progress
- Secure sponsorship fund transfers and signed agreements
- Strict safeguarding standards to protect all parties involved
