Transforming Lives Through Humanitarian Aid

Action For Humanity Canada (AFHC) is thrilled to share the impact of our work for 2025, highlighting our organization's efforts to provide critical aid to vulnerable populations worldwide.



HUMANITARIAN EFFORTS

AFH's team is working tirelessly to deliver essential support to those affected by conflict and displacement. Here are some key highlights:

50 PROJECTS

AFHC's successfully implemented 50 impactful projects across 11 conflict-affected countries, including Syria, Yemen and Palestine.

255,992 INDIVIDUALS REACHED

AFHC's efforts have reached 255,992 individuals and 50,758 families, providing them with critical aid and support.

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

AFHC has provided emergency assistance, healthcare, education, food aid, shelter, and income generation support to those in need.



PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

AFHC is committed to providing a range of programs that support vulnerable populations. Here are some of the initiatives AFHC is working on:

Healthcare:

AFHC is providing medical care and support to those in need, including emergency medical assistance and healthcare services. AFHC's healthcare programs have reached 71,012 individuals, including 19,503 households.



Food Aid:

AFHC is delivering food aid to those in need, including emergency food assistance and nutritional support. AFHC's food aid programs have reached 48,143 individuals, including 7,839 households.



Education:

AFHC is working to provide education and educational resources to children and families affected by conflict and displacement. AFHC's education programs have reached 6,838 individuals, including 1,686 households.



Shelter:

AFHC is providing shelter and housing support to families and individuals affected by conflict and displacement. AFHC's shelter programs have reached 5,101 individuals, including 1,203 households.



STORIES OF HOPE

Basima's Story:

📍 Saida, South Lebanon

Basima, a 25-year-old woman, is receiving emergency assistance with her elderly father, finding dignity and safety amid displacement. "May Allah reward you greatly for all your good deeds," she says.

Ma'amoun's Story:

📍 Sanaa, Yemen

Ma'amoun, a young orphan, found a safe space and support through our sports program, enabling him to thrive. *"I've found a new sense of purpose through the sports program,"* Ma'amoun says.



Amal's Story:

📍 Masa Village, Qabasin, Aleppo, Syria

Amal, an 8-year-old girl, is receiving medical care for a rare condition, giving her family hope for her future. *"We're grateful for the medical care Amal received,"* her family says. *"It's given us hope for her future."*
