# A MESSAGE FROM OTHMAN



Alhamdulillah, the blessed month of Ramadan is upon us once again; a time for reflection, renewal, and compassion in action. It reminds us that faith is not only what we believe, but what we do. This year, as we turn our Faith into Action, we are called to embody the spirit of Ramadan through mercy, generosity, and solidarity with those in need.

Across the world, families continue to face immense hardship. In Palestine, the wounds of genocide run deep. In Syria, families who have endured fourteen years of war are finally returning home to rebuild. In Yemen, hunger and disease threaten millions, while in Pakistan and Lebanon, instability continues to devastate lives.

Yet amid hardship, I see hope because I see you. Through your faith, compassion has become action, and that action has changed lives.

Last Ramadan, your giving reached over **359,000 people** across eight countries with food, water, shelter, and healthcare. Together, we distributed **70,000** food parcels, served **over 185,000** hot meals, and provided urgent medical and health assistance to more than **35,000** Palestinians in Gaza.

In total, Action For Humanity has now reached **over 16 million people** in 15 countries, proof that our faith, when put into action, knows no borders.

With one of the lowest administrative fees in the sector, and as a **Core Humanitarian Standard (CHS) accredited organisation**, we hold ourselves to the highest global standards of transparency and accountability. You can trust that your **Zakat, Sadaqah, Fidyah, and Fitran** reach those who need them most, delivered with dignity and impact.

This Ramadan, as we fast, pray, and give, let us remember that every meal shared, every home rebuilt, and every life restored begins with a single act of faith.

May Allah (SWT) accept our good deeds, bless our giving, and unite us in compassion and purpose. Together, let's turn our **Faith into Action** — for Palestine, for Syria, for humanity.





During Ramadan, when many go without even one proper meal, Action for Humanity's From Your Table to Theirs initiative ensures that the most vulnerable can break their fast with dignity, nourishment, and hope.

Through the distribution of essential food parcels, food vouchers, or the delivery of hot meals, the programme supports households in Syria, Yemen, Palestine, Pakistan, Lebanon, Jordan, Sudan, and Iraq.

# PALESTINE

Palestine continues to bear the scars of unimaginable loss. At least 70,000 people, including over 50,000 children, have been killed or injured in Gaza since October 2023\*. Half a million remain in catastrophic conditions, facing famine, disease, and displacement.

The recent ceasefire has finally enabled aid to reach Gaza, a crucial opening for families who have endured deplorable hardship. Yet the crisis is far from over. Homes lie in ruins, hospitals are overwhelmed, and clean water is scarce.

Amid the devastation, your faith has been a lifeline. Since 2023, Action For Humanity has reached over 1 million people with food, water, shelter, protection and healthcare in Gaza and Westbank. As Palestine begins to heal, your continued compassion will help rebuild lives with dignity and hope.

For two years, Hidaya has endured hunger, fear, and loss. Her home was destroyed, and her husband was injured in an airstrike. Each day, she searched for food, queuing for hours with her children for a single meal.

When Action For Humanity reached her community, our teams provided hot meals, clean water, and emergency medical care. It was the first time in weeks her family had eaten together.

Today, Hidaya and her children are rebuilding their strength in one of our HOPE shelters. Her story is one of survival, faith, and endurance, and it's only possible because of you.

# YOUR IMPACT IN PALESTINE 2023 - 25

Since October 2023, Action For Humanity has implemented over 100 life-saving interventions across Gaza, the West Bank, and Jerusalem. Amid one of the world's most difficult humanitarian crises, we have reached more than 1 million people, including 50,000 with disabilities, with vital aid.

Our support includes hot meals, food parcels, cash assistance, clean water, hygiene kits, medical supplies, and temporary shelters, alongside education programmes, psychosocial support, and solar-powered water projects. Despite severe access restrictions, our teams continue to serve families every day, protecting life, preserving dignity, and maintaining hope in Palestine.

# SYRIA

Fourteen years since the conflict began, Syria is taking its first steps towards recovery. Across liberated areas, families who were once displaced are finally returning home. But what they return to is devastation. Houses are reduced to rubble, schools are destroyed, and livelihoods have been lost.

Over the past year, Action for Humanity has expanded reconstruction efforts across northern Syria, transforming destruction into renewal through flagship projects such as Al-Tahrir Village, Bread for Syria, Gift For Life, and Water for Syria.

Your generosity is restoring safety, dignity, and the foundations of normalcy. In the first year of liberation, Action For Humanity has restored more than 10 social service facilities, launched multiple infrastructure projects, and established youth empowerment centres that enable women to take part in rebuilding Syria and strengthening their communities.

### LEBANON COMMUNITY BAKERY & KITCHEN



In Lebanon, soaring inflation and widespread poverty have left many families unable to meet their basic food needs. Action For Humanity's Community Bakery and Kitchen in Saida provides fresh bread and hot meals every day to vulnerable Lebanese, Syrian, and Palestinian families.

Beyond addressing immediate hunger, the initiative strengthens community resilience by engaging local volunteers and suppliers, fostering solidarity and social cohesion during the ongoing economic crisis.

### SUDAN COMMUNITY KITCHENS



Sudan's ongoing conflict has severely worsened humanitarian conditions across multiple states, including the Kordofan region. These kitchens offer a vital lifeline for families facing acute food insecurity.

## ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT AND SKILL-BUILDING

As humanitarian needs evolve, Action for Humanity continues to move beyond short-term relief toward sustainable recovery. These programmes embody this shift, building local enterprise, skills, and community-led innovation as pathways to lasting independence.



### SMALL BUSINESS STARTER KITS



We provide vulnerable women and young people in **Yemen, Syria, Pakistan, and Palestine** with small business starter kits to help them establish sustainable micro-enterprises. Kits include materials for tailoring, catering, crafts, or small-scale retail, selected based on local market needs. Participants also receive financial literacy and business training, supporting long-term independence and income generation.

This initiative strengthens local market capacity, promotes gender equality, and helps families transition from humanitarian assistance to lasting economic stability.


Our LIFE programme seeks to empower Syrian and Palestinian refugees, as well as young Jordanians, especially women and persons with disabilities, through vocational and life skills training.

The programmes address high unemployment and economic hardship by offering market-driven skills development in sectors such as handicrafts, cosmetics manufacturing, 3D design, and graphic design, paired with soft skills such as financial and digital literacy, to enable women to kickstart their own businesses or obtain suitable employment.
